

Dementia Factsheet



North Staffordshire/Stoke on Trent Dementia care Pathway

If you have:

- memory problems
- · changes in behaviour
- communication problems
- get confused
- struggle with everyday tasks

Visit your GP:

you will have an assessment you may be referred to the Memory Clinic



The Memory Clinic:

- · you will see a specialist
- you will have more assessments
- you may have some tests and scans
- the specialist will give you a diagnosis
- you will be given information on support services
- you may be referred to other agencies who can help you

Referral:

you will usually have an appointment in 4 - 6 weeks





Treatment:

Mild Cognitive Impairment:

you may be referred back to your GP with 6 months reviews or you may have more tests

Vascular Dementia:

you will have health and wellbeing checks and be referred back to vour GP

Alzheimer's Disease:

you may be offered treatment with a follow up review



After diagnosis:

you will have a care plan and a copy is sent to your GP your care plan will be reviewed every 12 months your carer will be offered support
